The church in Port-au-Prince continues to see growth in the Lord Jesus Christ. We had 11 Baptisms last month and 7 people make decisions as believers to become a part of the fellowship.

Our attendance at worship has been around 702. There are also 1000 students from kindergarten through High School. This includes the evening adult session of the school.

Our new guest house in Port-au-Prince is now open. There is room for about 54 people. Eddy says you must see it to appreciate it. Groups and guests coming to work in Port-au-Prince will be using this facility as they work.

We have continued to raise additional funds for computers that are desperately needed in Haiti to help teach the students. Please consider giving to this special need.

As always continue praying for the work in all three of our mission areas we are trying to reach in Haiti, including Limonade and Veretes. We praise God that we can work together to reach the impoverished nation of Haiti. As you support the work of PCM and Eddy Bazin you are making a difference for the Kingdom of God.
