The church in **Delmas** is doing well. The youth are making lots of progress. A few weeks ago we had a two-day seminar on personal evangelism involving the youth specifically which brought a group of other young people to the church of which 2 made decisions to accept Christ and were baptized. The Delmas church youth is built from men and women who either graduated from our school or are still attending the school. They have shown lots of interest in the gospel of Christ. One of them graduated from Christianville College and is now my Associate Minister at the Delmas Church. The church runs about 700 members in two services on Sunday mornings. The children's chapel is making lots of progress as well. Every year 12 - 14 young boys and girls graduate from the children's chapel and become a part of the adult worship. In April the women's group held a week-long revival with new women making decisions to get more involved in missions and church activities.



The **Limonade** church had a two-week revival in April. This is where PCM purchased a parcel of new land for the church in a town of great need. The church is looking to support a ministry to feed the children who attend the school one meal a day. More construction is planned for a new building with a school and a small medical clinic. Hopefully this project can begin in October 2009 – Please pray that God will supply the means to support and pay for this project.

**Adelphos School** operates under the Delmas Christian Church and has been a great blessing to the community. We have more than 1000 students from the 1200 that started in October 2008. Some have dropped out due to lack of money. We pray that through increased offerings to PCM we can increase our support for students to attend our Christian school and get the education they need.
